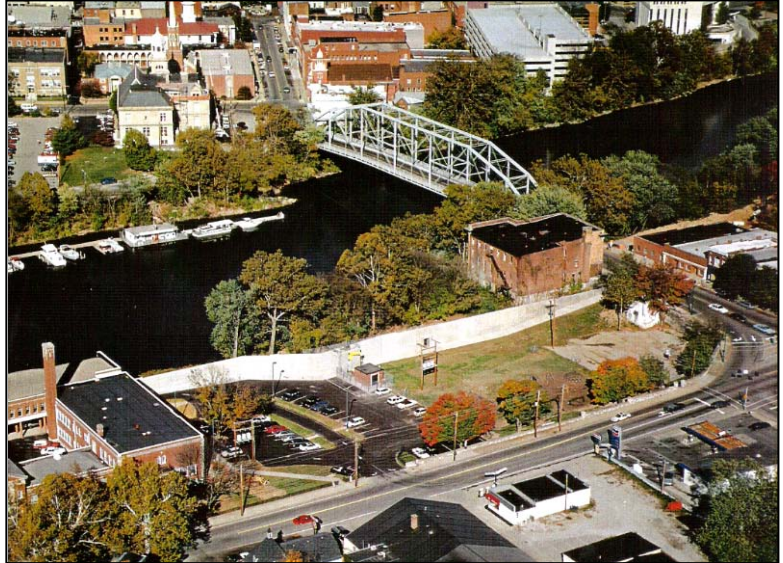

**PROJECT**

This project consisted of constructing a Flood Control Wall and Pumping Station in the south sector of Frankfort, Kentucky (Kentucky's Capitol City). Additionally, another Flood Control Pumping Station was constructed in another section of the city. The pump-out stations each could pump flows in excess of 100 million gallons per day assuring empty of the City of Frankfort's surface waters during flooding periods. The concrete floodwall was constructed on some of the property of the existing elementary school at the top of the river's bank. The floodwall stretched city blocks. Protection of school children was of grave importance; therefore, attention to safety was vital to the construction phase.
